**FALL COLOR ROUNDUP** offers APHA (American Paint Horse Association), PtHA (Pinto Horse Association of America), PHBA (Palomino Horse Breeders of America) & ABRA (American Buckskin Registry Association) approved classes as well as All Breed classes. Breed association classes are eligible for year end high point awards in the NM Paint Horse Club, the Pinto Horse Assoc. of NM, the NM Palomino Exhibitors Assoc. & the NM Buckskin Assoc. All breed classes are PAC (Paint Alternative Competition), SOAR (Pinto Select Opportunities & Rewards) approved and P3 eligible (Palomino Performance Program). All breed classes may also qualify for year end awards in NM Paint Horse Club, Pinto Horse Assoc. of NM, the NM Buckskin Assoc. & NM Palomino Exhibitors Assoc. Contact your local NM club or visit their websites or facebook pages for complete year end award rules for each breed.

### **PAINT, PALOMINO, PINTO, BUCKSKIN AND ALL BREED FEES (including FUN CLASSES):**

**OFFICE FEE:** \$30.00 per horse OR \$20.00 with pre-entry (complete info for horse, owner, and exhibitor(s) and one class has been entered prior to show date) – pre-entries will be accepted in the show office by 7 pm Friday evening before show. If mailing entries, please allow enough time to reach the show secretary by Thursday, October 24<sup>th</sup>. If emailing entries, they must be received by 5 pm on Thursday, October 24<sup>th</sup>. Pre-payment not required. Scratches will not be charged if done prior to start of show Saturday morning at 8 am. NO REFUNDS for scratches made after start of show without veterinarian or doctor certificate.

**STALLS &/OR TACK ROOM:** A stall reservation form is required for all horses (equines) on the show grounds whether stalling at the fairgrounds or showing out of trailer. Stall &/or Tack Rooms are \$25 per day or any part of the day or night. ALL horses will be charged either a stall or trailer tie out fee. For shared tack rooms, one exhibitor will be charged full tack room fee (show secretary will not split these fees).

Shavings, hay, and feed can be purchased from the feed store, 4-W Feed, on the fairgrounds. Feed store onsite phone (505) 259-5341. Please call ahead to order shavings and/or feed and to confirm hours feed store is open or to make arrangements to have shavings waiting at your stall upon arrival.

**WORKING OUT OF TRAILER (trailer tie out fee):** A stall reservation form must be completed for all horses (equines) on the show grounds whether stalling at the fairgrounds or showing out of trailer. Tie out fee is \$15.00 per day per horse (ALL horses will be charged either a stall or trailer tie out fee).

**RV HOOK UP:** \$35.00 per day with HOOK UP or \$25.00 per day NO HOOK UP (Those staying in trailer overnight will be charged fee).

**TRAIL EQUIPMENT SET FEE:** \$5 per horse showing in Trail OR Ranch Trail. This fee will also allow schooling using equipment set up in the outdoor warm up arena Saturday late afternoon and Sunday morning prior to start of show. As a courtesy to fellow exhibitors, please leave pattern and obstacles as set.

### **PAINT ENTRY FEES:**

APHA (Paint) Show Assessment Fee: \$2.00 per horse, per judge = \$4.00 for show.

OPEN ENTRY FEES: \$18.00 per class **OR** \$90.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers both judges) per Open Division (Regular or Solid Paint Bred). APHA Open division based on horse (can have multiple exhibitors).

AMATEUR CLASSES: \$18.00 per class **OR** \$90.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers both judges) per Amateur Division (Regular or Solid Paint Bred). **Amateur All Show Flat Entry Fee allows an amateur to show in any APHA amateur division, where eligible, including walk/trot amateur, novice amateur and amateur AND the SAME horse and rider combination may cross enter in APHA open classes, where eligible, for FREE.** APHA Amateur all show flat entry fee based on one horse/one rider.

YOUTH CLASSES: \$10.00 per class **OR** \$50.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers both judges) per division (Regular or Solid Paint Bred). **APHA Youth All Show Flat Entry Fee allows the SAME horse and rider combination to show in any APHA Youth classes (18 & under, 13 & Under and/or walk/trot ages 5-10, where eligible) AND the SAME horse and rider combination may cross enter in APHA open classes, where eligible, for FREE.** APHA youth all show flat entry fee based on one horse/one rider.

**+++ADD A BREED SPECIAL: If paying a Paint all show flat entry fee, enter the corresponding Palomino, Pinto and/or Buckskin Div. for \$35 per breed (per Open or Amateur) or two additional breeds for \$70 (per Open or Amateur), \$20 (Youth)! See details in box on page 3. +++**

#### PALOMINO ENTRY FEES:

**FYI – A Palomino Representative will be onsite Friday evening before the show to help you complete palomino registrations. You can pay your membership and register your horse Friday evening and then show AT THIS SHOW! GREAT IDEA IF YOU WANT TO GET PALOMINO OR PALOMINO BRED PAPERS ON YOUR PAINT, PINTO OR BUCKSKIN! If you need help completing your PHBA registration application, PLEASE schedule prior to show date with Berniece Zielke at 505-702-2246 (call or text).**

PHBA (Palomino) Show Assessment Fee: \$7.00 per horse, per judge = \$14.00 for show.

OPEN ENTRY FEES: \$18.00 per class **OR** \$90.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers both judges) per Open Division (Palomino or Palomino Bred). PHBA Open division based on horse (can have multiple exhibitors).

AMATEUR CLASSES: \$18.00 per class **OR** \$90.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers both judges) per Amateur Division (Palomino or Palomino Bred). **Amateur All Show Flat Entry Fee allows an amateur to show in any PHBA amateur division, where eligible, including walk/trot amateur, novice amateur and/or amateur AND the SAME horse and rider combination may cross enter in PHBA open classes, where eligible, for FREE.** PHBA Amateur all show flat entry fee based on one horse/one rider.

YOUTH CLASSES: \$10.00 per class **OR** \$50.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers both judges) per division (Palomino). **PHBA Youth All Show Flat Entry Fee allows the SAME horse and rider combination to show in any PHBA Youth classes (18 & under, Novice and Walk/Trot, where eligible) AND the SAME horse and rider combination may cross enter in PHBA open classes, where eligible, for FREE.** PHBA youth all show flat entry fee based on one horse/one rider.

**+++ADD A BREED SPECIAL: If paying a Palomino all show flat entry fee, enter the corresponding Paint, Pinto and/or Buckskin Div. for \$35 per breed (per Open or Amateur) or two breeds for \$70 (per Open or Amateur), \$20 (Youth)! See details in box on page 3. +++**

#### PINTO ENTRY FEES:

**FYI – A Pinto Representative will be onsite Friday evening before the show to complete pinto registrations. You can pay your membership and register your horse Friday evening and then show AT THIS SHOW! GREAT IDEA IF YOU WANT TO GET PINTO PAPERS ON YOUR PAINT OR SOLID! PLEASE schedule prior to show date with Marilyn Novat at 505-865-6568.**

PtHA (Pinto) Show Assessment Fee: \$5.00 per horse, per judge = \$10.00 for show.

PtHA (Pinto) Class Fee: \$1 per horse, per class.

**Please note that Pinto entries MUST be made on official Pinto entry form! Only Pinto entries may be made on this entry form. In classes designated by Type (Stock & Hunter or Pleasure Type), horse MUST be shown in type indicated on PtHA registration Papers. In Pinto classes with no designated type, all Pinto Horses may be shown.**

OPEN ENTRY FEES: \$18.00 per class **OR** \$90.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers both judges) per Open Division (Regular or Solid Pinto). PtHA Open division based on horse (can have multiple exhibitors).

AMATEUR CLASSES: \$18.00 per class **OR** \$90.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers both judges) per Amateur Division (Regular or Solid Pinto). **Amateur All Show Flat Entry Fee allows an amateur to show in any PtHA amateur division, where eligible, including walk/trot amateur and/or amateur AND the SAME horse and rider combination may cross enter in PtHA open classes, where eligible, for FREE.** PtHA Amateur all show flat entry fee based on one horse/one rider.

YOUTH CLASSES: \$10.00 per class **OR** \$50.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers both judges) per division (Regular or Solid Pinto). **PtHA Youth All Show Flat Entry Fee allows the SAME horse and rider combination to show in any PtHA Youth classes (18 & under, Novice and Walk/Trot, where eligible) AND the SAME horse and rider combination may cross enter in PtHA open classes, where eligible, for FREE.** PtHA youth all show flat entry fee based on one horse/one rider.

**+++ADD A BREED SPECIAL: If paying a Pinto all show flat entry fee, enter the corresponding Paint, Palomino and/or Buckskin Division for \$35 per breed (per Open or Amateur) or two breeds for \$70 (per Open or Amateur), \$20 (Youth)! See details in box on page 3. +++**

#### BUCKSKIN ENTRY FEES:

ABRA (Buckskin) Show Assessment Fee: \$1.00 per horse, per judge = \$2.00 for show.

OPEN ENTRY FEES: \$18.00 per class **OR** \$90.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers both judges) per Open Division (Buckskin or Buckskin Bred). ABRA Open division based on horse (can have multiple exhibitors).

AMATEUR CLASSES: \$18.00 per class **OR** \$90.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers both judges) per Amateur Division (Buckskin or Buckskin Bred). **Amateur All Show Flat Entry Fee allows an amateur to show in any ABRA amateur division, where eligible, including walk/trot amateur and/or amateur AND the SAME horse and rider combination may cross enter in ABRA open classes, where eligible, for FREE.** ABRA Amateur all show flat entry fee based on one horse/one rider.

YOUTH CLASSES: \$10.00 per class **OR** \$50.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers both judges) per division (Buckskin). **ABRA Youth All Show Flat Entry Fee allows the SAME horse and rider combination to show in any ABRA Youth classes (18 & under and Walk/Trot, where eligible) AND the SAME horse and rider combination may cross enter in ABRA open classes, where eligible, for FREE.** ABRA youth all show flat entry fee based on one horse/one rider.

**+++ADD A BREED SPECIAL: If paying a Buckskin all show flat entry fee, enter the corresponding Paint, Palomino and/or Pinto Division for \$35 per breed (per Open or Amateur) or two breeds for \$70 (per Open or Amateur), \$20 (Youth)! See details in box on page 3. +++**

**+++ADD A BREED SPECIAL: If paying a Paint, Palomino, Pinto or Buckskin Open or Amateur All Show Flat Entry Fee of \$90 (or Youth Fee of \$50), add another breed (Paint, Palomino, Pinto or Buckskin) for \$35 (per Open or Amateur) or \$20 (youth) all show flat entry fee!+++**  
**Add a breed special covers both judges. Please ask if you have questions.**

**DOES NOT APPLY TO ALL BREED DIVISIONS.**

**EXAMPLES:**

1. Pay open Paint division flat entry fee of \$90 and show in open Pinto division for all show flat entry fee of \$35 or \$18/class whichever is less AND show in all open Paint and Pinto Classes for a total entry fee of \$125 OR
2. Pay youth Paint all show flat entry fee of \$50 and show in Pinto youth and open for all show flat entry fee of \$20 or \$10/class whichever is less. OR
3. Pay open Paint division flat entry fee of \$90 and show in open Pinto AND open Buckskin divisions for all show flat entry fee of \$35 per division (\$70 for 2 additional divisions) or \$18/class per breed whichever is less.

**Important!!! ENTRIES IN MULTIPLE DIVISIONS WILL NOT BE COMBINED FOR ALL SHOW FEES except as noted for Paint, Palomino, Pinto and Buckskin Amateur and Youth Exhibitors!**

**ALL BREED ENTRY FEES:**

OPEN, AMATEUR AND YOUTH CLASSES: \$10.00 per class (covers both judges) **OR** \$50.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers both judges) per Division. There are **SIX** All Breed Divisions: Open, Open Walk/Trot, Amateur, Amateur Walk/Trot, Youth and Youth Walk/Trot, each with own flat entry fee and high point award. All breed Amateur and Youth all show fees are based on one horse/one rider in one division.

**FUN CLASS ENTRY FEES:**

\$10.00 per class. Fun classes do NOT count towards any high point show or year end awards.

JACKPOT 50% of entry fees (payout schedule: less than 5 in class – winner takes all; 5 – 10 in class – winner 60%, 2<sup>nd</sup> 40%; 11 – 15 in class – winner 50%, 2<sup>nd</sup> 30%, 3<sup>rd</sup> 20%; 16+ in class – winner 40%, 2<sup>nd</sup> 30%, 3<sup>rd</sup> 20%, 4<sup>th</sup> 10%.

Prize to Winner of each class. Rosettes through sixth place.

Fun Classes:

#10 – All Breed Color Costume Class open to Horse of any color or painted any color. Costume required for exhibitor or horse or both. In hand only class (horse can be saddled but not ridden in this class).

#133 – Stick Horse Reining (bring your own stick horse or ride one furnished by show management). Abbreviated Reining Pattern (using smaller arena) will be posted at least one hour prior to class. Open to all levels of competitors.

#200 – All Breed Adult Leadline. Parent, Grandparent or Spouse to ride. Horse must be led by Child or Grandchild (9 years of age or older) or Spouse. No stallions allowed in this class. Adult may exhibit in English or Western attire. Equipment on horse must correspond with exhibitor attire, including a saddle adjusted so that exhibitor's feet are placed properly in stirrups. Exhibitors will enter ring at a flat footed walk. The class may be worked at a walk and/or trot both directions of the ring. In the lineup, the judge may ask the riders to back. The contestant must exhibit some knowledge of equitation. Judging will be on the rider. A lead shank of at least six feet long must be attached to the shank of the bit or to a halter that is under the bridle so that while the rider is in the ring, the horse is controlled by the handler (leader).

#215 – All Breed Western Fun Class. Class procedure will be announced October 15<sup>th</sup> or before and may consist of egg on a spoon, pairs, boot scramble, disciplined rail or any combination of these contests. Practice them all.

#277 – All Breed English Fun Class. Class procedure will be announced October 15<sup>th</sup> or before and may consist of toilet paper pairs, chin apple, cider sippin' or any combination of these contests. Practice them all and be prepared.

**CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES – ALL BREEDS CHALLENGE:**

Classes: #38 Halter Stallions

#70 Halter Geldings

#102 Halter Mares

#134 Reining

#241 Walk/Trot Western Pleasure

#242 Western Pleasure

#281 Walk/Trot Hunter under Saddle

#282 Hunter under Saddle.

NO ENTRY FEE but horse and exhibitor MUST qualify for Championship Class by placing 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> under either judge in the corresponding all breed or breed class of the same class (such as halter, reining, western pleasure, etc.). Horse must be shown by same exhibitor who qualified horse for Championship Class unless exhibitor has qualified more than one horse.

Example - to show in the All Breeds Challenge Championship Halter Geldings Class, the horse and exhibitor MUST have placed 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> under either judge in All Breed Halter Geldings (open, amateur or youth), in a Paint RR or SPB Geldings Class (open, amateur or youth), in a Pinto Geldings Class with color or solid (open, amateur or youth), in a Palomino or Palomino Bred Geldings Class (open, amateur or youth) or in a Buckskin or Buckskin Bred Gelding Class (open, amateur or youth).

Reining Championship will be based on highest reining score (average from both judges in one class) received in classes 124 – 132.2. Tie breaker judge will be chosen by show management. If a tie remains, tie will be broken by flip of coin until winner is declared. A separate class will not be run.

In the Walk/Trot Championship Classes (western pleasure and hunter under saddle), only a rider (and horse) showing only in walk/trot classes at this show will be allowed to compete for the Walk/Trot Championship. If a horse and rider has competed in all breed walk/trot and also shows in a walk/trot/lope (or canter) class in all breed or a breed approved class, they may NOT compete in either Walk/Trot Championship Class. The horse may have competed in walk/trot/lope classes with a different exhibitor. Championship classes will be judged by one judge (except reining where both judge's scores count). Prize to winner of each Championship Class. Rosettes through sixth place. Championship Classes do NOT count towards any show or year end high point awards. If you have questions, please ask. Show management reserves right to clarify Championship class rules if questions arise. Their decision will be final.

**PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS IS NOT A TRAINING SHOW AND TRAINING DEVICES ARE NOT ALLOWED IN ANY CLASSES.**

**MISCELLANEOUS:**

In breed classes (APHA, PtHA, PHBA, ABRA), an exhibitor may NOT show in walk/trot classes and walk/trot/lope (canter) classes at the same show.

In the All Breed Division, an exhibitor may show in walk/trot classes and in walk/trot/lope (canter) classes.

Youth may NOT cross enter leadline and walk/trot or walk/trot/lope (canter) classes.

Two minute gate call allowed on classes. No exceptions.

Exhibitors requiring and requesting special accommodations should consult their breed association rulebooks for procedures regarding applying for variances. If not covered by breed rules, APHA rules will prevail.

Questions concerning rules as published may be presented to Show Management for clarification. Their decision will be final.

**CONCURRENT CLASSES:**

When classes are run concurrently, i.e. all entries in classes 6.1 & 6.2 will be in the arena together, you are NOT required to enter both, all three classes or in some cases all four classes. You may enter only the class(es) you choose and will only earn points (towards show awards, state points and national points) in the class(es) which you entered and paid an entry fee; i.e. if you entered a Pinto Solid Class running concurrent with a Buckskin Class, you must enter and pay for both classes if you want to earn points for both the Pinto and Buckskin classes. Only enter breed classes that your horse has registration papers for. Please ask if you have questions.

**You CANNOT post enter a class.**

**PRE ENTRIES: Highly recommended but not required.** Office fee is \$20.00 for exhibitors submitting horse, owner and exhibitor information and entering one class prior to show date. This will speed check in and entry process on day of show and save you money. Office fee if entering day of show is \$30.00. Pre-payment of entry fees or stalls is not required. Scratches made prior to start of show (Saturday, October 26th, 8 AM) will not be charged. NO REFUNDS for scratches will be made after start of show except when a class has been cancelled by show management or due to incapacitation of horse or exhibitor. Veterinarian certificate or doctor's note required for refunds and ultimate decision on refunds will be made by show management. Class entries (including adding classes) can be made day of show.

**Class entry deadlines are as follows:**

Saturday	Color, Halter and Lungeline by 7:30 AM Remainder of Saturday Classes (Showmanship, Reining, Ranch Rail Pleasure, Ranch Pleasure, Ranch Riding and Ranch Trail) by 9:00 AM
Sunday	In Hand Trail and Trail by 7:30 AM Leadline, Western Pleasure, Horsemanship, Hunter under Saddle and Hunt Seat Equitation by 9:30 AM

**NO gate entries will be accepted in ANY classes.**

Stall reservations required for a guaranteed stall. Show sponsors will be given preferential stall assignments. All horses (equines) must complete a stall reservation form whether stalling at fairgrounds or working out of trailer.

## **HORSE SHOW INFORMATION**

### **HORSE SHOW AWARDS**

High Point and Reserve High Point Division Awards in each Breed and All Breed – OVER 40 HIGH POINT AWARDS OFFERED! Show High Point Awards will be awarded after the points have been totaled and audited for each division (Breed color points are counted in point totals within a division but do not satisfy either requirement for halter or performance classes). Due to the number of breeds and divisions, high point results may not be available at conclusion of show on Sunday. Results will be posted as soon as possible on facebook pages and websites.

To qualify for High Point and Reserve High Point Division Awards:

OPEN Paint RR, Paint SPB, Pinto (with color), Pinto Solid, Palomino, Palomino Bred, Buckskin, Buckskin Bred and All Breed – must show in Three (3) Performance Classes plus Halter OR Four (4) Performance Classes. Points kept on horse in Open Divisions. Can have multiple riders (exhibitors). Color points are included in high point tabulation but color classes do not satisfy requirement for either halter or performance class participation.

WALK/TROT OPEN All Breed – must show in Three (3) Performance Classes. Points kept on horse in Open Divisions. Can have multiple riders (exhibitors). Halter and Color points DO NOT count in this division.

AMATEUR Paint RR, Paint SPB, Pinto (with color), Pinto Solid, Palomino, Palomino Bred, Buckskin, Buckskin Bred and All Breed – must show in Three (3) Performance Classes plus Halter OR Four (4) Performance Classes. Points kept on horse & rider team in all Amateur Divisions. Amateur Color, when offered, points are included in high point tabulation but color classes do not satisfy requirement for either halter or performance class participation.

NOVICE AMATEUR Paint RR & Palomino – Three (3) Performance Classes. Halter and Color points DO NOT count in these divisions. Points kept on horse & rider team in all Amateur Divisions.

WALK/TROT AMATEUR Paint RR, Paint SPB, Pinto (with color), Pinto Solid, Palomino and Buckskin & All Breed – Three (3) Performance Classes. Halter and Color points DO NOT count in these divisions. Points kept on horse & rider team in all Amateur Divisions.

YOUTH Paint RR, Paint SPB, Pinto (with color), Pinto Solid, Palomino, Buckskin, and All Breed – Three (3) Performance Classes plus Halter OR Four (4) Performance Classes. Points kept on horse & rider team in all Youth Divisions. Youth Color, when offered, points are included in high point tabulation but color classes do not satisfy requirements for either halter or performance class participation.

In Paint RR, Pinto (with color), Palomino and Buckskin Youth classes run as 18 & Under, youth awards in these divisions will be split into two age groups: 13 & Under and 14-18.

Paint SPB, Pinto Solid, and All Breed Youth Awards will be 18 & Under.

NOVICE YOUTH Paint RR, Pinto (with color) & Palomino – Three (3) Performance Classes. Halter and Color points DO NOT count in these divisions. Points kept on horse & rider team in all Youth Divisions.

WALK/TROT YOUTH Paint RR, Pinto (with color), Palomino (two divisions: Ages 5-9 and Ages 10-18), Buckskin & All Breed – Three (3) Performance Classes. Halter and Color points DO NOT count in these divisions. Points kept on horse & rider team in all Youth Divisions.

**REMINDER!! TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR YEAR END HIGH POINT AWARDS IN NM PAINT HORSE CLUB, PINTO HORSE ASSOC. OF NM, NM PALOMINO EXHIBITORS ASSOC. OR NM BUCKSKIN HORSE ASSOC. YOU MUST BE A MEMBER!! PLEASE CHECK WITH YOUR CLUB FOR ALL REQUIREMENTS!**

**ALL BREED EXHIBITORS WILL NEED TO DESIGNATE WHICH ORGANIZATION(S) SHOULD RECEIVE THEIR RESULTS. IF NOT SPECIFIED ON ENTRY FORM, RESULTS WILL ONLY BE FURNISHED TO NMPHC (PAINT).**

**NMPHC will accept All Breed results towards All Breed year end awards provided membership is paid and work requirement is met (or work fee paid). Please consult with PtHANM, NMPEA and NMBHA to verify that All Breed Results will be accepted for their year end awards programs.**
