Deadline for Registration and Transfer Special – March 31, 2019

PHBA is reducing registration and transfer fees through March 31, 2019 (postmark date). Current membership required when registering or transferring ownership of a horse. Registration special includes Palomino and Palomino Bred and Color & Conformation Registry (for horses not registered with another breed association that PHBA recognizes, geldings and spayed mares only; all horses must meet color and conformation requirements). After March 31, 2019, PHBA will reinstate the regular registration and transfer fee schedule.

Effective January 1, 2019, the PHBA National Point Scale was revised. National points are now awarded when there are two exhibitors in a class with the 1st place horse earning one point. The rest of the point schedule remains the same. See schedule below.

NMPEA YEAR END AWARDS PROGRAM

2019 SHOW SEASON –

November 1, 2018 through October 31, 2019

Nomination fees for enrollment in NMPEA year end awards program: \$20 enrollment fee per horse allows one horse to be shown by any exhibitor in any division for one fee. Exhibitor(s) and horse owner(s) must be members of PHBA and NMPEA. Points for amateur and youth will be tabulated on one horse and one exhibitor team. Points for open are tabulated on horse (can have multiple exhibitors). Enrollment forms, complete rules and program flyer are available online at www.nmpea.com.

Points from all PHBA sanctioned classes held in NM will count towards NMPEA year end awards and a horse must show in at least one PHBA sanctioned class held in NM to be eligible for awards.

AND, up to six non sanctioned shows held in NM can be SUBMITTED BY AN EXHIBITOR to count towards NMPEA year end awards. Mail or email report card (or acceptable

substitute) to point keeper no more than 30 days after the end of a show or event (or by November 15th if show is October 15th or later). Report cards can be found online at www.nmpea.com.

If you have questions about your membership, showing, and/or awards; please be sure to ask prior to your first show. Make sure all your "i's" are dotted and "t's" are crossed so you're eligible for year end awards. Memberships and most other business can be taken care of at a show prior to showing. IMPORTANT NMPEA MEMBERSHIP INFO:

When you pay a membership to the national palomino association, PHBA (Palomino Horse Breeders of America), it includes your NMPEA membership if you reside in NM. The membership card you receive from PHBA designates which state affiliate you belong to. If there is not an active state affiliate in the state where you reside, you can designate what state affiliate you wish to be a member of on your membership application form. NMPEA also offers affiliate memberships to those who reside outside NM.

The NMPEA membership received from PHBA allows you to vote in NMPEA elections, and hold office in NMPEA and as a state affiliate national director, and to participate in programs offered by NMPEA such as the year end award awards program and participation awards. Some programs require an additional fee to help fund the program.

For those of you unfamiliar with the P3 Program, it is open to registered PHBA Palomino and Palomino Bred horses showing in classes other than PHBA classes. The show record becomes part of your horse's permanent show record.

Enrollment is \$20 annually for one horse/one rider. Report cards must be submitted to PHBA for them to record and tabulate points. Certificates are awarded at 25, 50, and 100 points earned within the calendar year. More information can be found on the PHBA website at www.palominohba.com.
