Wright's Rockin Horse Indoor Arena will be available for schooling from 5-8 pm on Friday, August 16.

Outdoor arena available for schooling upon arrival.

RED CHILE FIESTA offers APHA (American Paint Horse Association), PtHA (Pinto Horse Association of America), PHBA (Palomino Horse Breeders of America) and ABRA (American Buckskin Registry Association) sanctioned classes. Breed association classes are eligible for year end high point awards in the NM Paint Horse Club, the Pinto Horse Assoc. of NM, the NM Palomino Exhibitors Assoc. and the NM Buckskin Assoc. All breed classes are PAC (Paint Alternative Competition), SOAR (Pinto Select Opportunities & Rewards) approved and P3 eligible (Palomino Performance Program). All breed classes may also qualify for year end awards in NM Paint Horse Club, Pinto Horse Assoc. of NM, NM Palomino Exhibitors Assoc. and the NM Buckskin Assoc. Contact your local NM club or visit their websites or facebook pages for complete year end award rules for each breed.

PAINT, PINTO, PALOMINO, BUCKSKIN AND ALL BREED FEES:

OFFICE FEE: \$30 per horse OR \$20 with pre-entry (complete info for horse, owner, and exhibitor(s) and one class has been entered prior to show date – pre-entries will be accepted in the show office by 7 pm Friday evening before show). If emailing entries they must be received by 10 am on Friday, August 16th. If mailing entries, please allow enough time to reach show secretary by Thursday, August 15th. Pre-payment not required. Scratches will not be charged if done prior to start of show Saturday morning.

STALLS AND/OR TACK ROOM:

All horses (equines) on grounds must complete reservation form whether using stall, tack room or working out of trailer.

PREMIUM Stall (indoor stall facing arena): \$55 one day or night (or any part of a 24 hour period). \$90 circuit fee (includes Fri eve arrival).

STANDARD Stall (all non-PREMIUM stalls): \$45 one day or night (or any part of a 24 hour period). \$70 circuit fee (includes Fri eve arrival).

Premium and Standard Stall fees include 2 bags of shavings (delivered to stall if pre-ordered).

Outside shavings are not allowed at Wright's Arena as shavings must meet specific requirements for their recycling and composting program.

Stall reservations required if you want a guaranteed stall (**reservation form must be completed for all equines on grounds**).

If needing additional shavings, please call ahead to order. \$11/bag.

There will be a limited number of DAY Stalls available in south shed row stall area. DAY stall fee: \$25 per day (or any part of day).

NO shavings & NO overnight use in Day Stalls

Tack Room: \$25 per day (or any part of a 24 hours period). \$50 circuit fee (includes Friday evening arrival). For shared tack rooms, one exhibitor will be charged full tack room fee (show secretary will not split tack room fees).

WORKING OUT OF TRAILER (trailer tie out fee): All horses (equines) on grounds must complete stall reservation form whether using stall, tack room or working out of trailer. No Charge to work out of trailer.

RV HOOK UP: \$35 per day with electric HOOK UP only.

TRAIL EQUIPMENT SET FEE: \$5 per horse showing in Trail OR Ranch Trail. This fee will also allow schooling using equipment set up in the outdoor warm up or indoor arena Saturday (after conclusion of classes in that arena) and Sunday morning prior to start of show. As a courtesy to fellow exhibitors, please leave pattern and obstacles as set.

CATTLE FEES (MUST BE PREPAID WITH CATTLE RESERVATIONS BY AUGUST 7TH, 2019): \$45 per head/per go. If you are showing in a class running concurrently with another breed and are entered in both classes (such as Paint & Pinto Working Cowhorse), an entry fee will be charged for each class entered but you will have one cattle run and one cattle fee will be charged. Make check payable to NMPHC & send cattle pre-payment to: Ron Morris, PO Box 908, Belen, NM 87002. If class is cancelled by show management, refunds will be issued. FOR ALL CUTTING CLASSES: Exhibitors are responsible for providing their own turn back and herd holders. Failure to do so will result in contestant not being allowed to show and no refunds will be given. Two minute gate call.

PAINT ENTRY FEES:

APHA (Paint) Show Assessment Fee for Paint O Rama: \$5.00 per horse, per judge = \$15.00 for show.

OPEN ENTRY FEES: \$22.00 per class **OR** \$120.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers all three judges) per Open Division (Regular or Solid Paint Bred). APHA Open division based on horse (can have multiple exhibitors).

AMATEUR CLASSES: \$22.00 per class **OR** \$120.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers all three judges) per Amateur Division (Regular or Solid Paint Bred). **Amateur All Show Flat Entry Fee allows an amateur to show in any APHA amateur division, where eligible, including walk/trot amateur, novice amateur and amateur AND the SAME horse and rider combination may cross enter in APHA open classes, where eligible, for FREE.** APHA Amateur all show flat entry fee based on one horse/one rider.

YOUTH CLASSES: \$12.00 per class **OR** \$60.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers all three judges) per division (Regular or Solid Paint Bred). **APHA Youth All Show Flat Entry Fee allows the SAME horse and rider combination to show in any APHA Youth classes (18 & under and/or walk/trot ages 5-10, where eligible) AND the SAME horse and rider combination may cross enter in APHA open classes, where eligible, for FREE.** APHA youth all show flat entry fee based on one horse/one rider.

+++ADD A BREED SPECIAL: If paying a Paint all show flat entry fee, enter the corresponding Palomino, Pinto and/or Buckskin Division for \$40 per breed (Open &/or Amateur) or both Pinto & Buckskin for \$80 (Open and/or Amateur), etc. Or \$25 per breed (Youth)! See details in box next page. +++

PINTO ENTRY FEES:

FYI – A Pinto Representative will be onsite Friday evening before the show to complete pinto registrations. You can pay your membership and register your horse Friday evening and then SHOW AT THIS SHOW! GREAT IDEA IF YOU WANT TO GET PINTO PAPERS ON YOUR PAINT OR SOLID! PLEASE schedule prior to show date with Marilyn Novat at 505-865-6568.

PtHA (Pinto) Show Assessment Fee: \$5.00 per horse, per judge = \$15.00 for show.

PtHA (Pinto) Class Fee: \$1 per horse, per class.

Please note that Pinto entries MUST be made on official Pinto entry form! Only Pinto entries may be made on this entry form. In classes designated by Type (Stock & Hunter or Pleasure Type), horse MUST be shown in type indicated on PtHA Registration Papers. In Pinto classes with no designated type, all Pinto horses may show.

OPEN ENTRY FEES: \$22.00 per class **OR** \$120.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers all three judges) per Open Division (Regular or Solid Pinto). PtHA Open division based on horse (can have multiple exhibitors).

AMATEUR CLASSES: \$22.00 per class **OR** \$120.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers all three judges) per Amateur Division (Regular or Solid Pinto). **Amateur All Show Flat Entry Fee allows an amateur to show in any PtHA amateur division, where eligible, including walk/trot amateur and/or amateur AND the SAME horse and rider combination may cross enter in PtHA open classes, where eligible, for FREE.** PtHA Amateur all show flat entry fee based on one horse/one rider.

YOUTH CLASSES: \$12.00 per class **OR** \$60.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers all three judges) per division (Regular or Solid Pinto). **PtHA Youth All Show Flat Entry Fee allows the SAME horse and rider combination to show in any PtHA Youth classes (18 & under, Novice and Walk/Trot where eligible) AND the SAME horse and rider combination may cross enter in PtHA open classes, where eligible, for FREE.** PtHA youth all show flat entry fee based on one horse/one rider.

+++ADD A BREED SPECIAL: If paying a Pinto all show flat entry fee, enter the corresponding Palomino, Paint and/or Buckskin Division for \$40 per breed (Open &/or Amateur) or both Paint & Buckskin for \$80 (Open and/or Amateur), etc. Or \$25 per breed (Youth)! See details in box next page. +++

PALOMINO ENTRY FEES:

FYI – A Palomino Representative will be onsite Friday evening before the show to help you complete palomino registrations. You can pay your membership and register your horse Friday evening and then SHOW AT THIS SHOW! GREAT IDEA IF YOU WANT TO GET PALOMINO OR PALOMINO BRED PAPERS ON YOUR PAINT, PINTO OR BUCKSKIN! PLEASE schedule prior to show date with Berniece Zielke at 505-702-2246 (call or text).

PHBA Show Fee: \$7.00 per horse, per judge = \$21.00 for show.

OPEN ENTRY FEES: \$22.00 per class **OR** \$120.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers all three judges) per PHBA Open Division (Palomino or Palomino Bred). PHBA Open division based on horse (can have multiple exhibitors).

AMATEUR CLASSES: \$22.00 per class **OR** \$120.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers all three judges) per PHBA Amateur Division (Palomino or Palomino Bred). **Amateur All Show Flat Entry fee allows amateur to show in any PHBA amateur division, where eligible, including walk/trot amateur, novice amateur or amateur, AND the same horse and rider combination may cross enter in PHBA open classes, where eligible, for FREE.** PHBA Amateur all show flat entry fee based on one horse/one rider.

YOUTH CLASSES: \$12.00 per class **OR** \$60.00 PHBA All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers all three judges) per division (Palomino or Palomino Bred). **PHBA Youth All Show Flat Entry fee allows the same horse and rider combination to show in any PHBA Youth classes (18 & Under, Novice Youth and/or Walk/Trot classes where eligible) AND to cross enter classes in the PHBA open division, where eligible, for FREE.** PHBA Youth all show flat entry fee based on one youth/one rider.

+++ADD A BREED SPECIAL: If paying a Palomino all show flat entry fee, enter corresponding Pinto, Paint and/or Buckskin Division for \$40 per breed (Open and/or Amateur), etc. OR \$25 per breed (youth)! See details in box on next page. +++

BUCKSKIN ENTRY FEES:

ABRA (Buckskin) Show Assessment Fee: \$1.00 per horse, per judge = \$3.00 for show.

OPEN ENTRY FEES: \$22.00 per class **OR** \$120.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers all three judges) per Open Division (Buckskin or Buckskin Bred). ABRA Open division based on horse (can have multiple exhibitors).

AMATEUR CLASSES: \$22.00 per class **OR** \$120.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers all three judges) per Amateur Division (Buckskin or Buckskin Bred). **Amateur All Show Flat Entry Fee allows an amateur to show in any ABRA amateur division (Buckskin or Buckskin Bred), where eligible, including walk/trot amateur and/or amateur AND the SAME horse and rider combination may cross enter in ABRA open classes, where eligible, for FREE.** ABRA Amateur all show flat entry fee based on one horse/one rider.

YOUTH CLASSES: \$12.00 per class **OR** \$60.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers both judges) per division (Buckskin). **ABRA Youth All Show Flat Entry Fee allows the SAME horse and rider combination to show in any ABRA Youth classes (18 & under or Walk/Trot, where eligible) AND the SAME horse and rider combination may cross enter in ABRA open classes, where eligible, for FREE.** ABRA youth all show flat entry fee based on one horse/one rider.

+++ADD A BREED SPECIAL: If paying a Buckskin all show flat entry fee, enter the corresponding Paint, Pinto and/or Palomino Division for \$40 per breed (Open &/or Amateur) or both Paint & Pinto for \$80 (Open and/or Amateur), etc. OR \$20 per breed (Youth)! See details in box this page. +++

+++ADD A BREED SPECIAL: If paying a Paint, Pinto, Palomino or Buckskin Open or Amateur All Show Flat Entry Fee of \$120 (or Youth Fee of \$60), add another breed (Paint, Pinto, Palomino or Buckskin) for \$40 (open and/or amateur) or \$25 per breed (youth) all show flat entry fee! +++

Add a breed special covers all three judges. Please ask if you have questions.

DOES NOT APPLY TO ALL BREED DIVISIONS.

EXAMPLES:

1. **Pay open Paint division flat entry fee of \$120 and show in open Pinto division for all show flat entry fee of \$40 or \$22/class whichever is less AND show in all Paint and Pinto open Classes for a total entry fee of \$160 OR**
2. **Pay youth Paint all show flat entry fee of \$60 and show in Pinto youth and open for all show flat entry fee of \$25 or \$12/class whichever is less. OR**
3. **Pay open Paint division flat entry fee of \$120 and show in open Pinto AND open Buckskin divisions for all show flat entry fee of \$40 per division (\$80 for 2 additional divisions) or \$22/class per breed whichever is less.**

Important!!! ENTRIES IN MULTIPLE DIVISIONS WILL NOT BE COMBINED FOR ALL SHOW FEES except as noted for Paint, Pinto, Palomino and Buckskin Amateur and Youth Exhibitors!

ALL BREED ENTRY FEES:

OPEN, AMATEUR AND YOUTH CLASSES: \$10.00 per class (per single, double or triple judged classes) **OR** \$50.00 All Show Flat Entry Fee (covers all judges) per Division. There are **SIX** All Breed Divisions: Open, Open Walk/Trot, Amateur, Amateur Walk/Trot, Youth and Youth Walk/Trot, each division has separate flat entry fee and high point award (**EXAMPLE: Open Walk/Trot and Open are 2 separate divisions with separate awards**). Amateur and Youth all show fees are based on one horse/one rider in one division. Open division based on horse (can have multiple exhibitors).

PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS IS NOT A TRAINING SHOW AND TRAINING DEVICES ARE NOT ALLOWED IN ANY CLASSES.

Exhibitors requiring and requesting special accommodations should consult their breed association rulebooks for procedures regarding applying for variances. If not covered by breed rules, APHA rules will prevail.

PRE ENTRIES: Highly recommended but not required. Office fee is \$20 for exhibitors submitting horse, owner and exhibitor information and entering one class prior to show date. See deadlines for pre-entry discounts under fees on first page. This will speed check in and entry process on day of show and save you money. Office fee if entering day of show or after 7 pm on Friday before show is \$30. Pre-payment of entry fees or stalls is not required. Scratches made prior to start of show (Saturday, August 17, 8 AM) will not be charged. **No refunds for scratches will be made after start of show except when a class has been cancelled by show management or due to incapacitation of horse or exhibitor.** Veterinarian certificate or doctor's note required for refunds and ultimate decision on refunds will be made by show management. Class entries (including adding classes) can be made day of show.

Class entry deadlines are as follows:

NO gate entries will be accepted in ANY classes.

Two minute gate call allowed on all classes. No exceptions.

There are no speakers in the barn areas or the parking lots at Wright's Arena. Please stay alert and listen to announcements made in the arena regarding class locations and times.

While show management will do its best to keep all exhibitors informed, it is ultimately the exhibitors' responsibility to be ready at the gate when their class is called.

CONCURRENT CLASSES:

When classes are run concurrently, you are NOT required to enter both, three or all four classes. You may enter only the class(es) you choose and will only earn points (towards show awards, state points and national points) in the class(es) you entered and paid an entry fee; i.e. if you entered a Pinto Solid Class running concurrent with a Buckskin Class, you must enter and pay for both classes if you want to earn points for both the Pinto and Buckskin classes. National and show points will be reported and calculated using the number of horses entered in your class, not using the total number of horses in the concurrent class (see breed specific rules). If you are entering concurrent cattle classes, you'll only work cattle one time (and pay one cattle fee for that class) but you'll pay entry fees for each of the classes entered that are running concurrently such as Paint and Pinto. Please ask if you have questions.

You CANNOT post enter a class.

Stall & Cattle reservations: contact Ron Morris 505-417-6167.

Stall reservations required for a guaranteed stall. Show sponsors will be given preferential stall assignments. All horses (equines) must complete a stall reservation form whether stalling at Wright's Arena or working out of trailer.

Cattle reservations with pre-payment are due August 7th. Show management reserves right to cancel cattle classes if insufficient cattle have been reserved. Cattle fees will be refunded if classes are cancelled.

FOR ALL CUTTING CLASSES: Exhibitors are responsible for providing their own turn back and herd holders. Failure to do so will result in contestant not being allowed to show and no refunds will be given. Two minute gate call will be strictly enforced.

HORSE SHOW AWARDS

NMPHC (NM Paint Horse Club), PtHANM (Pinto Horse Assoc. of NM), NMPEA (NM Palomino Exhibitors Assoc.) and All Breed high point and reserve high point winners will be able to select awards from a number of items. Each high point and reserve will earn points (high points values may differ depending on breed) that can be used to "purchase" an award or "save" to pool with points earned at the April and July shows. Check out some samples at the awards store or in the awards catalog at show.

NMBHA (NM Buckskin Horse Assoc.) will award Buckskin high point and reserve awards.

Due to the number of breeds and divisions, high point results may not be available at conclusion of show on Sunday.

Results will be posted as soon as possible on facebook pages and websites.

HORSE SHOW RIBBONS: First through Sixth place ribbons in each class and Grand & Reserve Champion Halter ribbons under all three judges will be available in the horse show office.

PAINT:

Show High Point Awards will be awarded after the points have been totaled for each division (Open and Amateur color points are counted in open or amateur point totals but do not satisfy either requirement for halter or performance classes):

Must show in at least 1 halter and 3 performance classes OR 4 performance classes to be eligible for high point awards in the following divisions: Paint Youth 13 & Under, Youth 14-18 (note: for paint regular registry youth classes run as 18 & under, results will be split into the two age groups for high point awards), Amateur and Open AND Solid Paint Bred Youth 18 & Under, Amateur and Open.

Must show in at least 3 performance classes to be eligible for high point awards in the following divisions: Paint Walk/Trot Youth Ages 5-10, Novice Youth, Walk/Trot Amateur, Novice Amateur AND Solid Bred Walk/Trot Amateur. Halter and Color points are not counted in these divisions.

All Youth and Amateur division high points based on one horse/one rider. Open division high points based on horse (can have multiple exhibitors).

PINTO:

Show High Point Awards will be awarded after the points have been totaled for each division (Open and Amateur color points are counted in open or amateur point total but do not satisfy either requirement for halter or performance classes):

Must show in at least 1 halter and 3 performance classes OR 4 performance classes to be eligible for high point awards in the following divisions: Pinto Youth 13 & Under, Youth 14-18, (note: although pinto youth classes will be run as 18 & under, youth awards will be split into two age groups), Amateur and Open AND Solid Pinto Youth 18 & Under, Amateur and Open.

Must show in at least 3 performance classes to be eligible for high point awards in the following divisions: Pinto Walk/Trot Youth 10 & Under, Pinto Novice Youth, Pinto Walk/Trot Amateur AND Pinto Solid Horse Walk/Trot Amateur. Halter & Color points not counted in these divisions.

The Pinto Horse Assoc. of NM will present additional High Point Awards for the following Pinto Pleasure Type Divisions: Open, Amateur & Youth. Must show in at least 1 halter & 3 performance classes OR 4 performance classes to be eligible for the Pleasure Type High Point Awards (Color points to count but do not satisfy halter or performance class requirements).

Youth & Amateur division high points based on one horse/one rider. Open division high points based on horse (can have multiple riders).

PALOMINO:

Show High Point Awards will be awarded after the points have been finalized and audited for each division:

Must show in at least 2 classes in a division to be eligible for show high point awards in the following divisions: Palomino Youth 13 & Under, Youth 14-18 (note: although palomino youth classes will be run as 18 & under, youth palomino awards will be split into two age groups), Novice Youth, Youth Walk/Trot Ages 5-9, Youth Walk/Trot 10-18, Amateur, Novice Amateur, Amateur Walk/Trot and Open Horse AND Palomino Bred Youth 18 & Under, Amateur and Open Horse. Halter and Color points will count for high points only in Youth, Amateur and Open divisions (not in Novice Youth or Walk/Trot Youth or Walk/Trot Amateur).

Youth and Amateur divisions based on one horse/one rider. Open divisions based on horse (can have multiple exhibitors).

BUCKSKIN:

Show High Point Awards will be awarded after the points have been totaled for each division (Dun &/or Color points are counted in open point total but do not satisfy either requirement for halter or performance classes):

Must show in at least 1 halter and 3 performance classes OR 4 performance classes to be eligible for high point awards in the following divisions: Buckskin Youth 13 & Under, Youth 14 18, (note: although buckskin youth classes will be run as 18 & under, youth awards will be split into two age groups), Amateur and Open AND Buckskin Bred Open and Amateur.

Must show in at least 3 performance classes to be eligible for high point awards in the following divisions: Buckskin Walk/Trot Amateur AND Buckskin Walk/Trot Youth. Halter and Color points are not counted in these divisions.

Youth and Amateur division high points based on one horse/one rider. Open division high points based on horse (can have multiple exhibitors).

ALL BREED:

Show High Point Awards will be awarded after the points have been totaled for each division:

Must show in at least 1 halter and 3 performance classes OR 4 performance classes to be eligible for high point awards in the following divisions: All Breed Youth 18 & Under, Amateur and Open.

Must show in at least 3 performance classes to be eligible for high point awards in the following divisions: All Breed Walk/Trot Youth, Walk/Trot Amateur, and Walk/Trot Open. Halter points are not counted in these divisions.

Youth and Amateur division high points based on one horse/one rider. Open division high points based on horse (can have multiple exhibitors).

REMINDER!! TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR YEAR END HIGH POINT AWARDS IN NM PAINT HORSE CLUB, PINTO HORSE ASSOC. OF NM, NM PALOMINO EXHIBITORS ASSOC. OR NM BUCKSKIN HORSE ASSOC. YOU MUST BE A MEMBER OF THAT CLUB!! PLEASE CHECK WITH YOUR CLUB FOR ALL REQUIREMENTS!

ALL BREED EXHIBITORS WILL NEED TO DESIGNATE WHICH ORGANIZATION(S) SHOULD RECEIVE THEIR RESULTS. IF NOT SPECIFIED ON ENTRY FORM, RESULTS WILL ONLY BE FURNISHED TO NMPHC (PAINT). NMPHC will accept All Breed results towards All Breed year end awards provided membership is paid and work requirement is met (or work fee paid). Please consult with PthANM, NMPEA and NMBHA to verify that All Breed Results will be accepted for their year end awards programs.
