**Qualifying shows dates: November 1 - October 31 of following year, i.e. the 2026 show season dates are 11/01/25 – 10/31/26.

Membership and Enrollment Open to Exhibitors, Owners and Horses from Any State.

Points are earned based on NMPEA point system.

Open points are based on horse (can have multiple exhibitors). Youth & amateur points are accumulated on one horse/one rider.

Only shows held within the state of NM will count towards NMPEA year end awards.

Horse Registration Requirement	PHBA Registration Required (Palomino or Palomino Bred)
Annual Fee (non-refundable)	\$20.00 per horse
Enrollment Form	Required for each Horse along with copy of PHBA Registration and Membership Cards
Showing Requirements	Must show in at least one class in their division (open, amateur, novice amateur, youth, etc.). Up to six Non-NMPEA Shows Can Count.
Double Points Can be Earned	In All PHBA Classes held in NM
Work or Sponsorship Requirement	50 Volunteer Points Required (see volunteer info sheet)
